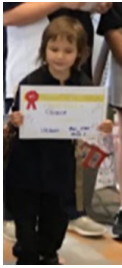

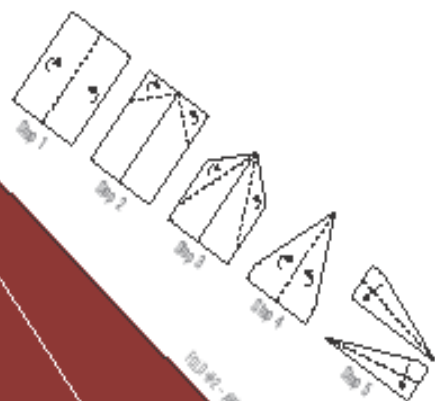
THE RESILIENCE PROJECT
